



Looking for training opportunities?

CareerSource Southwest Florida offers training opportunities to Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) eligible job seekers. Ask to speak with a Career Development Representative (CDR) for an individual eligibility screening. You must be 18 years of age, or older to apply for WIOA adult services.

*WIOA youth program applicants ages 16 and 17 must be accompanied by a parent or guardian.

Please be prepared to present the following information:

- Driver License (DL) or State Identification.
- Proof of date of birth - birth certificate, passport, record of birth.
- Proof of your social security number.
- If you are not a U.S. citizen you must provide alien registration card or certificate of naturalization.
- Males Born after December 31, 1959 must have registered for selective service by age 25. Males can begin registering on their 18th birthday. With only a few exceptions, the registration requirement applies to all male U.S. citizens and male immigrants residing in the United States. Visit <https://www.sss.gov> for more information.

** currently out of school youth can be attending Adult Education classes.*

Additional information may be needed to complete eligibility determination for other WIOA services requested:

- ⇒ Proof of last 6 months total household income.*
- ⇒ Last five years of work history including: employer name, address and phone number, position held, wage and reason for leaving.
- ⇒ Proof of Unemployment Compensation if out of state.
- ⇒ Copy of high school diploma, General Equivalency Diploma, college degree (if applicable).

* for purposes of household income a family is defined as two or more persons related by blood, marriage or decree of court that is living in a single residence and is (1) a husband, wife and dependent children, or (2) a parent or guardian and dependent children, or (3) a husband and wife.

Training opportunities may include, but not limited to:

- Occupational skills training – choose from a variety of programs and schools listed on the eligible training provider list found at <http://careersourcesouthwestflorida.com/occupations-in-demand/>
- On-the-Job training (OJT) – earn while you learn the skills necessary to successfully do the job.
